The Options: (All these must be taken by *faith*)

Evolution

Man evolved from some primordial slime.

The second law of thermodynamics. * (See below)

An illustration: The evolution of an automobile.** (See below)

Why unsaved people choose this theory. See 1 Cor. 2:14

Theistic evolution.

God used the evolutionary process to create man.

This compromise makes the Scriptures unreliable.

Creation.

God created man as the Scriptures teach.

It's logical: A *thing* is preceded by a *thought* of a *thinker*.

God's Plan

To create man. Genesis 1:26

From the dust of the ground. Gen. 2:7

In the image and likeness of God. Gen. 1:27

To give man a free *choice*.

To obey God.

To disobey God.

To allow man to be tempted. Gen. 3:1-7

By the tempter-Satan through the serpent. Rev. 12:9

To be like God knowing good from evil.

God's Foreknowledge. Acts 15:18

Man would *rebel*.

Eve was deceived. 1 Tim. 2:14

Adam wasn't deceived. Gen. 3:6

Man would *suffer the consequences*.

Spiritual and physical death. Gen. 2:17; 5:5; Romans 6:23

An old sin nature. Psalm 51:5; 1 John 1:8

Women-pain in childbirth. Gen. 3:16

Men-curse on the ground. Gen. 3:17-19

Man would be *corrupt*. Gen. 6:5 (God's description of man)

Spiritually dead. Eph. 2:1,5

God's enemy. Rom. 5:8,10

Energized by Satan. Eph. 2:2

Darkened understanding. Eph.4:18

Can't please God. Rom. 8:8

Guilty before God. Rom. 3:19

An old sin nature. 1 John 1:8

Totally depraved. Rom. 3:10

Doesn't seek God. Rom. 3:11

Warped emotions. Eph. 2:3

Won't choose God. Jn. 15:16

Can't save himself. Rom. 3:20
